CANBY

In the charming town of Canby off Hwy 99, visit the Depot Museum, the oldest remaining railroad station in Oregon. Many of the surrounding farms in this bountiful area offer U-pick fruits and vegetables and U-cut flowers from spring to fall.

Swan Island Dahlias has more than 40 acres of brilliant flowers and is one of the country's largest growers. Visitors should plan to visit from August through September when the dahlias bloom.

The historic **Canby Ferry** runs daily on the Willamette River. This is one of the last operating car ferries on the Willamette and a perfect ride to the fertile farms in the area. The ferry is accessible from Hwy 99E or I-5 at exit 288.

WILSONVILLE

Wilsonville has earned the Tree City USA designation.

Oregon Korean War Veterans Memorial, located in Town Center Park, is a sweeping expanse of Carnelian granite containing the names of Oregon servicemen killed in the Korean War.

OREGON CITY

On I-5 north of Wilsonville is the junction with I-205, which skirts around the east side of Portland. Several communities can be accessed from this route, including the former capital of the Oregon Territory, Oregon City. Explore the history of the Pacific Northwest in a city that has preserved the American pioneers' struggle to settle the West.

The **End of the Oregon Trail Interpretive Center** is a unique structure of wagon-shaped buildings that house theaters and an exhibit hall with scheduled programs and activities depicting the area's early history. The center is a great starting point for visiting the city's historical sites: the **Museum of the Oregon Territory** and the house of **John McLoughlin**, Father of Oregon.

For more history about the area, visit the **Stevens-Crawford House**, which was built in the early 1900s and is decorated in authentic period furnishings.

The **Ermatinger House and Living History Museum**, open for tours on weekends, was the home of Francis Ermatinger, a representative of the Hudson's Bay Company who built the house for his family in the 1840s. It was the first frame house in town.

MILWAUKIE/HAPPY VALLEY

The town of Milwaukie is in north Clackamas County on the Willamette River and near both the Clackamas and Columbia rivers, so water recreation is popular for most of the year.

The **Milwaukie Historical Mural** depicts the history of the area between 1800 and 2000. The four large panels of the mural can be seen on Adams Street.

SANDY

Sandy is the gateway to Mount Hood recreation along Hwy 26.

Don't miss stunning views of Mount Hood and the Sandy River from the **Jonsrud Viewpoint** along the path of the historic Barlow Road portion of the Oregon Trail.

BORING

Boring is also in Clackamas County, between Sandy and Gresham along Hwy 26. The town is home to the Pacific Northwest training center of Guide Dogs for the Blind.

Springwater Corridor is a 17-mile paved trail made from a former railway that now serves as a hike/bike trail from southeast Portland to

Boring. The trail connects with many other trails around Portland and the Gorge.

VILLAGES OF MT. HOOD

From Portland, visitors travel Hwy 26 east to Mt. Hood. The route passes the mountain villages of Alder Creek, Brightwood, Wemme, Welches, Zigzag, Rhododendron, and Government Camp. These are the best bets for finding accommodations, restaurants, galleries, shops, and visitor services on the way to and from the mountain.

Government Camp is a gateway to several major ski resorts and also hosts a small resort that is a good spot for beginning skiers.

At **Timberline Lodge and Ski Area**, the Palmer Express high-speed quad whisks skiers to the 8,540-foot level of Mt. Hood's south face.

Mt. Hood National Forest offers campgrounds, lakes, rivers, and trails. Summertime visitors come for hiking, biking, fishing, camping, and climbing. More than two dozen SnoParks around Mt. Hood and off of Hwy 26 attract winter crowds. ❄️
